Recipe of the month

55g/2oz root ginger peeled & grated
1 tsp olive oil
675g/1.5lb pumpkin flesh cubed
30g/1oz butter
575ml-1.1litre/1-2 pt veg. stock

Throw the ginger into a large pan with oil & butter, sauté for a few seconds, then add the pumpkin. Place a close fitting lid on the pan and leave over low heat for 15 minutes.

Leave to cool and then liquidize adding enough of the stock to make the consistency of the soup you like. You will achieve a richer flavour (+ fatter bottom) by adding more butter.
