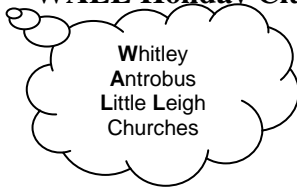

RASPBERRY & PINENUT BARS

8oz plain flour
8oz porridge oats
250g pack butter, cut into small pieces and softened.
6oz light muscovado sugar
Finely grated zest of 1 lemon
100g pack pine nuts
9oz raspberries
Takes 1 hour, makes 12

Pre-heat oven to 170C. Butter shallow 9" square tin. Tip the flour, oats and butter into bowl, mix with fingers to make coarse crumbs

Mix in the sugar, lemon and 3/4 of the pine nuts. Using hands, press mixture well to form large sticky clumps.

Drop 2/3rds of the oat mixture into the tin. Spread out and press lightly. Scatter raspberries on top. Sprinkle rest of mixture over, and press everything down lightly.

Bake 35-40minutes. Cut into 12 bars with sharp knife, leaving tin to cool.
