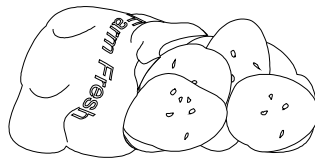

DAMSON TART

Ingredients:

4oz Caster Sugar, 4oz Butter, 1 egg, 8oz
Self-raising flour, 1/2 tspn Almond
essence, 12oz damsons, halved &
stoned, 1oz demerara sugar

1) Mix butter, caster sugar, egg, almond
essence and flour together to form a
breadcrumb mix. (ie blitz together in a
food processor)

2) Push into a 10" round, or 9" square
greased tin

3) Arrange damsons on top, sprinkle
demerara sugar on top.

4) Bake for 30mins at 190C, 375F until
golden brown

5) Eat warm with cream or custard, or
eat at room temperature.
