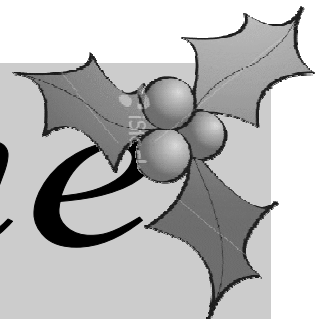

Many thanks to all those who were
able to come to the meeting to discuss
the idea of setting up a "Friends of St
Michael's Church."

The idea is to establish an independent
charitable organisation to safeguard
the Church building in the heart of the
village, support its maintenance and
provide an association for both social
and fund raising purposes.

There is a lot of support for the idea.
The Church is 130 years old and at-
tracting a lot of historical interest as
well as providing a symbol of a very
worthy and meaningful tradition with
its roots permeating many families
within the area.

Currently there is a group of loyal pa-
rishioners who seek to maintain the
building on behalf of the community.
Such an arrangement, with all the es-
calating costs these days, is unsustain-
able and it is felt that many more peo-
ple would like to share some of the
responsibility for it, even if they do
not get there very often themselves. It
as to be stressed this only relates to
caring for the building.

It was agreed that a Friends Group
would be set up in the form of a loose
association of members contributing
about £15 a year. It would have a
clearly defined constitution, a small
committee of about three members
and up to about 4 organised social
events during the year.

In order to get more feedback from
everyone interested the Church will be
open on Saturday 19th December from
10-4pm when there will be mince pies
and refreshments and there will be
music from Hilary Totten and Eric
Grice, yet to be announced.

Then on January 12th we are planning
to hold a public meeting in the hall at
7.30pm to talk about the whole issue
and see what we want to do with our
very own "Friends."
