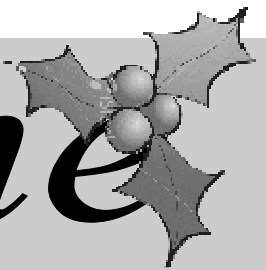

Headed by the Royal Harvesters, the procession included the retiring Queen, Hazel Harvey and the Queen-designate and their retinues, Audrey Withenshaw (bouquet bearer) and John Howman (crown bearer) served Margaret while Mary Hazelhurst, Dorothy Woodward, Cathie Harvey and Winifred Howman acted as maids of honour for the retiring Queen."
